Psalm 124

Feast of the Holy Innocents Evening Prayer Monday Week 3

To the title 'A Song of Ascents', Psalm 124 adds 'Of David.' It is a liturgical hymn of thanksgiving (verse 6) to YHWH for having saved the people from extreme danger.

The style of these verses is found only in a few texts in Old Testament:

If you had not ploughed with my heifer, you would not have found out my riddle.

- Judges 14:18

If YHWH of hosts had not left us a few survivors, we would have been like Sodom, and become like Gomorrah.

– Isaiah 1:9

If YHWH had not been my help,

I would soon have lived in the land of silence.

– Psalm 94:17

Fire and water are the two elements most commonly used to describe destruction.

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.

- Isaiah 43:2

You delivered me from choking fire on every side ... from the deep belly of Hades.

- Sirach 51:4-5

Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly; he often falls into the fire and often into the water.

- Matthew 17:15

We are to put our trust in YHWH.

I trust in God and am not afraid. What can a mere mortal do to me?

- Psalm 56:11

I, I am he who comforts you; why then are you afraid of a mere mortal who must die, a human being who fades like grass?
